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## Workshop Descriptions:

**D2L Basics:** This workshop will go over the basic layout and functionality of D2L. Topics will include navigation, content, html editor and course copy.

**D2L Discussion Forums:** This workshop will get you ready to set up your own discussion forums topics in D2L and link them to the gradebook. This will include setting up restrictions, views and submission options.

**D2L Gradebook and Assessment:** This workshop will provide you the tools necessary to set up and link gradebook to assignments, quizzes and other assessments.

**Windows10/Office365:** This workshop will give you the skills you need to navigate the latest window operating system. Become familiar with the look and feel of the new Windows10 layout and Office365 is the same office you already know and use every day. However, Office365 is powered by the cloud, so you can access your applications and files from virtually anywhere. This workshop will provide you an overview of the new Office365 layout as well as some short tips and tricks to leverage Office365 in your daily tasks.

**Outlook 2016/Calendar:** This workshop will help boost your communication skills and increase productivity in the workplace with a quick overview of the new email layout, customization, tips and tricks a well as other tools that are available.

**Zoom/Skype/YouSeeU:** Want to learn ways to engage your students outside of the classroom setting. Come and see if this tool is for you. This workshop will provide an overview of what Zoom can do for you and if this tool would benefit you and your students as well as an added option for multi-conferencing and online collaboration. FREE accounts are available to all users and limited Pro accounts have been purchased for those powers uses who require more options than a FREE account can offer. **Skype for Business:** This workshop will provide you with an overview of how Skype can be used for intra-campus videoconferencing, not just an instant messaging tool. **YouSeeU:** This workshop will provide you with an overview of this interactive web based tool within D2L (Only available within the LMS)

**Quality D2L Distance Education Course Design:** Have you built your D2L Distance Education DEV Shell yet? Even if you have, do you see room for improvement? Are you interested in quality distance education course design? Participants will be shown how to design a quality distance education course based on DTCC's Quality Assurance Rubric.

**Low Tech and High Tech Learner Engagement Strategies:** Do you want to get your students more engaged in the learning process? Low tech and high tech strategies for engaging learners in the learning process both inside and outside the classroom will be explored during this session. We will also explore tools within D2L that can be used to improve learner engagement.

**Strategies for Recording, Storing, and Sharing Self-Made Instructional Videos:** Participants will learn how to use Screencast-O-Matic to record their screen, how to upload the video to their DTCC YouTube account, and how to share the link to the video within the LMS (either Blackboard or D2L). Closed Captioning options in YouTube will be discussed. Information about the George Campus Innovation Studios will be presented.

**Video Conference Tools Strategies:** Participants will learn how to use the video conferencing tools Zoom and YouSeeU (built into D2L). We will explore strategies that use these tools to create a more engaging and interactive learning environment in distance education courses.

**Course Planning using the Principles of Backward Design:** The Understanding by Design (Grant Wiggins and Jay McTighe) framework for curriculum planning and design will be explored in this session.
